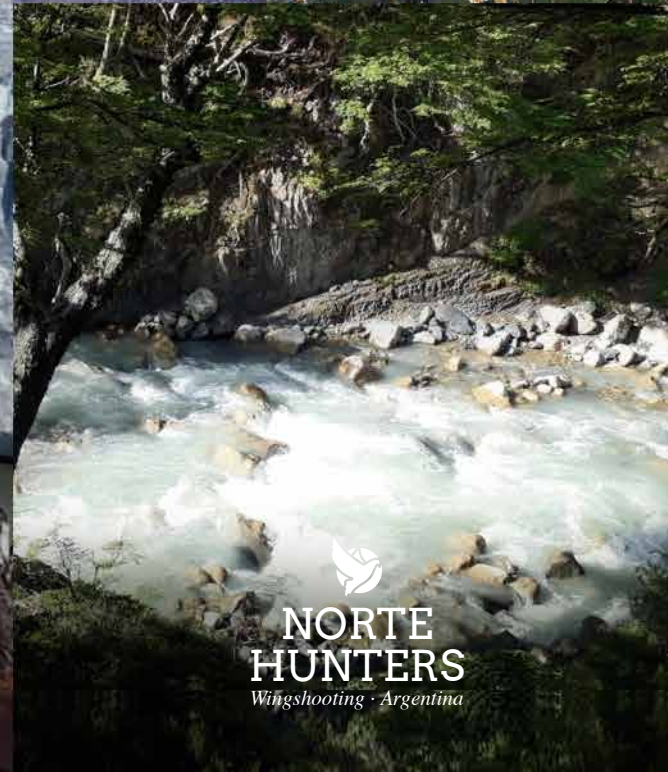

PATAGONIA



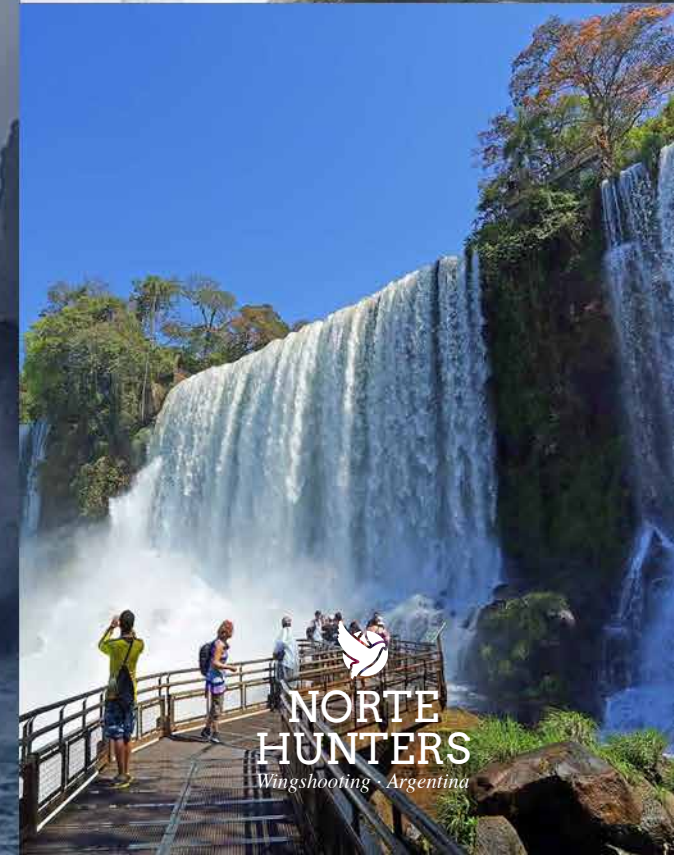
Patagonia owns impressive landscapes. Volcanoes' summits with geyser and hot springs; mountains from which huge glaciers, lakes and rivers descend. Charming valleys and mountain villages surrounded by millenary native forests or large steppe fields. Four World Heritage sites stand out – Los Glaciares National Park, Cueva de las Manos (Hands Cave), Los Alerces National Park and Valdés Peninsula.

IGUAZU FALLS

Declared one of the Seven World Natural Wonders, located inside Iguazú National Park, the waterfalls were formed as a result of a volcanic eruption. It is a system of 275 waterfalls in the middle of the Paraná Jungle, located at 17 km away from where the borders of Argentina, Brazil and Paraguay meet. These impressive waterfalls are 2.7 km (1,7 miles) wide. The height ranges from 60 m (200 feet) to 82 m (269 feet), and they have an average water volume of 1,800 cubic meters per second.



WINE ROUTE

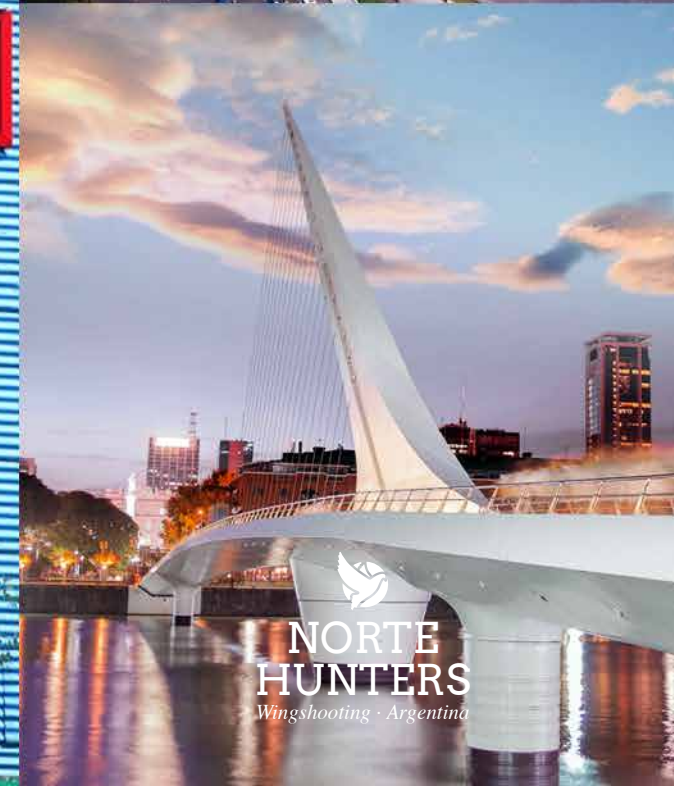


Mendoza stands out for the Wine Route, as it concentrates the major wine production in the country and variety of grapes (Malbec, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, Chenin and Riesling, Bonarda, Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinot and Syrah). And you can choose from a variety of wineries, more than one thousand, to visit grape harvest, going on bike-tours or horse-riding tours among vineyards and visiting their theme museums.
